### Introductory week

Kick off with a comprehensive introductory week featuring a taster of all basic skills. This week allows both the instructor and student to identify specific interests and focus areas for the remainder of the course.

Materials and Tools: Overview of clay types and essential tools.

Basic Techniques: Introduction to key techniques for potter's wheel and hand-building.

Taster Sessions: Hands-on experience with both potter's wheel and sculpting. Identifying Interests: Discussions to assess individual preferences and skill levels. Goal Setting: Outline personal goals for the specialisation.



# Weeks 2-4: Specialised Practice

(Choose one specialisation or a mix)

#### Potter's Wheel

Fundamental Skills: Centering, throwing, and shaping techniques.

Advanced Techniques: Exploration of complex forms and functional pieces.

Personal Projects: Focus on individual projects with instructor support.

# Hand-Building

Core Techniques: Pinch pot, coil, and slab building.

Advanced Hand-Building: Combining techniques for sculptural and functional forms.

Personal Projects: Development of individual artistic voice and projects.

The monthly fee of Rs.40,000 includes tuition, practice materials and a hearty vegetarian meal a day from our home kitchen.
